

Packing List for Regional 2010 Father/Son Camps

All items should be marked with last name. There are no laundry facilities available.

- Tent (large enough to also house gear in case of rain) – unless you plan to stay in a cabin or other accommodations
- Sleeping bag (rated to 20° F for northern based camps, otherwise 35° F is fine)
- Sleeping pad (optional but recommended)
- Pillow (optional)
- Daypack (for carrying items needed throughout the day)
- 2 one-liter canteens or water containers per person or hydration system
- Pocket knife (Do not carry on the airplane!)
- Flashlight (with extra batteries)
- Map compass
- Bible (KJV)
- Pen and pencil, notebook
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Towel
- Toiletry items
- Rain gear or poncho
- Whistle
- Basic first-aid kit
- Tarp (to put under the tent)
- 100 ft. 550-paracord (available at www.thealertstore.us) or similar
- Uniform components (note if there is no formal church service on Sunday, the dress uniform components can be omitted)
 - Issued green chambray
 - Green Cadet T-shirts
 - Green LTC polo shirts (for LTCs)
 - Khaki Dickies dress pants (for church)
 - Khaki BDUs (relatively new)
 - Khaki BDUs (can be an older pair)
 - Black tie (for church)
 - Black dress belt (for church)
 - BDU belt
 - Black dress shoes (for church)
- PT uniform
 - Green ALERT Cadet or deployment T-shirt,
 - Green ALERT Cadet sweat shirt
 - Green ALERT Cadet sweat pants (optional)
 - Green ALERT Cadet shorts
- Jacket/coat and gloves/mittens (for evenings and cool weather, if expected)
- Swimsuit (optional)
- Shower shoes (flip-flops)
- Running shoes
- Hiking boots (broken-in)
- Underwear (enough to last for the whole camp)
- Socks (athletic, boot, and black)
- Bicycle and helmet (optional but useful for Big Sandy based camps)

Additional items for service projects (see the camp final details letter for specifics)

- Work gloves (mandatory)
- Safety glasses or goggles (mandatory)
- Basic hand tools
